RSPCA SYDNEY SHELTER RAISES MONEY FOR QUEENSLAND FLOOD VICTIMS

In an effort to raise much-needed funds for the RSPCA Queensland flood appeal, the RSPCA Sydney Shelter will host a barbeque tomorrow, 15 January from 9:30am to 2:00pm.

Community member and fundraiser Dianne Mayne has been helping to raise money for RSPCA NSW for nearly two years. "We hold a barbeque every couple of weeks at the Sydney Shelter, and the funds typically go to RSPCA NSW Inspectors and Shelters," said Ms Mayne. "But everyone agrees that tomorrow's funds will go toward helping Queensland's flood victims."

The Bankstown Fire Brigade will also be on site to help support the cause.

"The floods have been absolutely devastating, and have impacted so many people and animals," said Ms Mayne. "So we're hoping for a really good turnout tomorrow. If all goes well, we may hold a few more barbeques to raise even more money for Queensland."

All food served at tomorrow's barbeque will meet RSPCA's Humane Food standards and is sourced from non-intensive farming systems.
