Woman to face Windsor court over alleged cruelty to dogs and horses

A Rouse Hill woman is due to appear in Windsor Local Court today (**Wednesday October 25**), charged with a total of 17 offences in relation to the alleged cruel treatment of four horses and four dogs.

The 45 year old faces eight charges of failing to provide proper and sufficient food and nine charges of failing to provide veterinary treatment.

All charges are under the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act (POCTA) 1979.

RSPCA NSW Metropolitan Inspectors Skye Adams and Matthew French will attend the mention on behalf of the RSPCA.

The mention is expected to be heard at **9.30am today (Wednesday October 25)**
